Kalina Mrmevska, piano

Hailed by critics as "a pianist of enviable power," "an artist of clear and vivid vision," award winning pianist Kalina Mrmevska made her debut at the age of 9, winning first prizes in Macedonian and Yugoslavian competitions. At 12, she performed a Bach piano concerto with the Macedonian Philharmonic. At 18, she represented Macedonia at the European Broadcasting Union's Eurovision Contest for young musicians, performing at Warsaw Philharmonic Hall, in Poland. She took first prize at the International Piano Competition for Young Talents "Rovere d'Oro" in San Bartolomeo, Italy, and second prize at the International Piano Competition "Schumann-Young Chang" in Macugnaga, Italy.

Mrmevska has performed as a recitalist, chamber musician and orchestra soloist in Italy, France, Turkey, Germany, Spain, USA, Macedonia, Bulgaria, Poland, and Serbia, in venues such as: Musikhalle Hamburg; Macedonian Philharmonic Hall; Warsaw Philharmonic Hall; Robert and Judy Newman Center for the Performing Arts (Denver); Telekom Zeneház Concerto and Danube Palace, Budapest; and Staller Center, Stony Brook, New York. She has performed at festivals such as Interlochen Summer Arts Camp, Stars von morgen"(Concert in Cooperation mit "Villa Musica" Rheinland Pfalz, Germany); "Concerti di Musica Classica" (7` Festival Europeo dei Duchi d'Acquaviva, Italy); Ohrid Summer Festival, (Macedonia); II Semana Grande del Piano - Circulo Industrial- Asociación de Amigos De La Música De Alcoy, Spain; Stony Brook Chamber Festival, NY; International Keyboard Institute & Festival at Mannes College, New York. Her recent engagements include solo and chamber music recitals in USA and Spain, and a European tour (Germany, Hungary, Austria and Macedonia) of the piano-cello duo Art Vanguard which she co-founded and which uniquely performs works by Twentieth and Twenty-first Century composers along with traditional Balkan, Eastern and Central European music.

She is a recipient of a German DAAD scholarship, as well as scholarships from the Otto-Stoterau Stiftung and the Oscar and Vera Stiftung. During her stay in the USA, she has received the Jeff Bradley Award from the University of Denver, Colorado, as well as the prestigious Staller Scholar Award from the State University of New York at Stony Brook, where she completed her Doctoral of Musical Arts in piano performance under the mentorship of the renowned pianist and pedagogue Gilbert Kalish.

As a humanitarian activist, Mrmevska was chosen to be the first Child Consul for the First Children's Embassy in the World-Megjashi in the Republic of Macedonia, an NGO instrumental in rescuing thousands of children put at risk by the Balkan wars. In this role she gave concerts, met with heads of state, and was interviewed by the media. She was awarded the "13th November Prize of the City of Skopje," given annually for outstanding achievement in economy, science, education, health-care, engineering, publication, sports, and the arts. The event is attended by the President of Macedonia. In 2006 Mrmevska appeared in *Shadows*, a film directed by Academy Award nominee Milcho Manchevski. In her native Macedonia, she often appears on national media, and in Chicago, where she performed in the prestigious Dame Myra Hess concert series with violinist Kinga Augustyn, she was broadcast live over WFMT.

Ms. Mrmevska is also an active teaching artist and educator. At Stony Brook University in New York, she coached individual piano students and the undergraduate chamber music ensembles. She taught undergraduate courses in History of Music and Theory as an Adjunct Faculty, and was Assistant to the Director of the children's and adults programs at the Community Music Program. As a teacher of individual students, she has had great success. One of her students won a soloist competition in 2015 allowing him to perform at Merkin Hall in Lincoln Center. In the summer of 2016, one of her students took a first prize at the Danube International Masterclass and Competition.

In addition, Mrmevska serves as a regular jury member at various competitions, including the Long Island Conservatory Soloist Competition, Danube International Concerto Competition, Sound Symphony Solo Competition and Yamaha Piano/Breckenridge Concerto Competition.

Deeply committed to promoting Macedonian music, Mrmevska has given US and world premieres of Macedonian composers such as Vlastimir Nikolovski and Risto Avramovski. Her next CD will feature further examples of this genre.

In 2016 Mrmevska joined the faculty at Danube International Concerto Masterclass and Competition in Budapest, Hungary where she also served as a co- Artistic Director of the Summer Academy. In 2019 she joined the distinguished piano faculty at Scriabin Summer Piano Academy in Tuscany, Italy, where she continues to teach individual lessons and lecture on selected topics from the history of European music. In the summer of 2023 Ms. Mrmevska was invited to join Interlochen Summer Arts Camp where she was coaching as a collaborative pianist and performing in a solo and chamber music recitals as well as with WYSO under the baton of Erina Yashima.

Orchestra Society, whose board includes Yo-Yo Ma and Emmanuel Ax. Further engagements to follow in 2019/20 and 2021/22 in USA and Europe, will include Artist in Residence at various universities and colleges in USA, including Tennessee Tech University, Houston Community College, as a soloist with Chandler Symphony Orchestra, and recitals at various concert series such as the German Consulate in New York and festivals throughout US and Europe, among them the Vierne Festival, Belgium, and Ohrid Summer Festival, Macedonia with the violinist Nadja Nevolovitsch. There will also be a European tour of Dr. Mrmevska's Duo Art-Vanguard. Engagements in the Fall of 2023 will include a Guest Artist at Campbell University as a part of the Emerging Composers concert series; premiering Macedonian works at Spectrum NYC and a soloist with Palisades Sinfonietta.
